Where else offers you free stand space, free tickets plus reduced track time.*

Castle Combe Action Days offer all this plus First Class facilities, big crowds and a great atmosphere, a chance to meet your fellow Club members, display your cars and project your Club message to your current and potential members. PLUS the chance to drive the challenge of Castle Combe Circuit.

Conditions are straight forward. Any Clubs can apply although space requirements mean not every Club may be accepted. Your Club's display and cars must be in keeping with the theme of the day, we expect you to put on a good show, and that is about it. Turn up and enjoy – just complete the application form. Clubs accepted will receive, free of charge, display space, 12 personal passes and up to 12 car display passes, plus massive discounts on advanced track passes.

**Reduced track time operates prior to 11.00 and after 16.00*

ELIGIBLE CARS – Your cars must suit the theme of the day.

Castle Combe Action Days are defined as an event designed to allow members of the public to drive their cars on a race circuit in a non-competitive recreational manner. Timed practice, pace making and racing is strictly not permitted. While most road based race prepared cars may be permitted to participate subject to noise and other conditions, an Action Day is specifically designed to be an event for drivers of road cars.

Cars must be to MOT standards to be eligible for the general sessions. Although the scrutineers reserve the right to refuse any car track time which, in their opinion, does not conform to our general regulations.

Please ensure also that your car is eligible for the theme of the day i.e., Minis only on the Mini Day, Classic, Retro and Sports cars only on June 6th and so on.

SOUND LIMITS – Your members cars will be tested

All vehicles using Castle Combe Circuit are sound tested. The limits are enforced throughout the day and are set at 100d(b)A measured at 4500rpm on a static test with the sound metre set at ½ metre from the exhaust outlet.

Your car, even if it is totally road legal, will not be allowed on the circuit if it does not meet these requirements. Sound checks can be carried out prior to purchasing Track passes, and Merlin Motorsport located at the Circuit, offer a range of bolt-on "Silencing Accessories."

BOOK AN EXCLUSIVE SESSION

Castle Combe Action Days still represents one of the cheapest ways of getting on circuit. Why not get some friends together or other owners clubs with similar types of cars and book an exclusive session. That way you know who is on the track with you, you can book a set time and just have fun.

Applications on the attached form must be submitted at least 1 month prior to the event, together with a letter on the Club's official headed notepaper, stating numbers of cars to be displayed.

CLUB DISPLAYS

Booking conditions

1. Club displays must remain within your allocated area. No part of your stand or display may extend beyond the area. No drilling or pegging into the tarmac areas.
2. Trailers should be parked in the allocated areas.
3. **Stand display vehicles**
Any vehicle displayed within your area will require a pass to gain entry via the appropriate gate. Please ensure these are distributed to your members as otherwise they will be directed to public car parks.
4. **Advanced entry tickets.**
Your vehicle display pass or track pass will not give you entry into the circuit or car parks. You will also need a personnel admission pass. These can be purchased in advance at a discounted rate. Just visit www.castlecombecircuit.co.uk, click on action days and when prompted add the code CCADO9 or purchased at the gate at normal rates.
5. **Entry to the display areas**
Various gates which will correspond with your vehicle display passes are clearly marked. Please enter by the correct gate which will allow you easier access to your display area and assist our staff.
6. Clubs are not permitted to trade from their display area with the exception of selling your own club merchandise.
7. Set up can be from 16.00 on the day prior to the day or from 07.00 on the day itself.
8. Site must be cleared by 19.00 on the day of the show.*
9. I.C.E. demonstration or playing of loud music in any of the display areas is strictly forbidden.
10. **Health & Safety**
As an Exhibitor, Contractor or Agent, you have a duty under The Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 to ensure that all personnel, contracted by you, are aware that they have a responsibility, so far as is reasonably practicable, for the health, safety and welfare of all employees, and that any plant or systems of work which may be used are, so far as is reasonably practicable, safe and without risks to health. This includes that all employees are provided with information, instruction, training and supervision to ensure not only their own health and safety, but also that of others working or attending the vicinity.
Castle Combe Action Days accept no liability for loss or damage to vehicles or property belonging to, nor liability for any injury or harm to exhibitors or traders or their employees or helpers or club officials and members.
All structures erected by traders and exhibitors must be safe and pose no danger to members of the public. Shelters must be adequately secured or weighted to prevent them being lifted by winds. Traders and exhibitors are requested to remove bulky waste from site. Bins are provided for general litter.
11. **Insurance**
Clubs should hold the necessary insurance against claims by third parties for fire, damage and all other risks. Clubs must also indemnify the event organisers against any claims for damage and or any expense incurred for whatever reason arising out of the Clubs attendance and and/or exhibits on the action day site. **A representative of the Club who will be present on the day must be named as responsible for all health and safety matters relating to the Club members and their displays and driving standards.**
12. A full driving licence must be produced when required.
13. Your passes give you track access for the time shown. You must attend a safety briefing prior to using the circuit, please arrive at least 40 minutes prior to your track pass time. If you miss your track time your pass is invalidated.
14. **Refunds**
Our refund policy is as follows
 - A. Once booked a full refund (less 25% administration fee) will be given if all passes are returned a week prior to the event
 - B. Refunds are not given for track passes if you miss your allocated time or briefing on the day.
 - C. Refunds are not given in the event of bad weather.
 - D. Club packages. Track passes are transferable, but not refundable.
 - E. Advanced public. 2 hours prior to track time is required plus £10 handling fee.
15. **Passes**
Passes will be sent once full payment is received. These should then be distributed to your members.
You will receive (provided it is ordered and paid for)
 - A. Admission tickets which will be required by each driver and passenger to gain entry to the circuit and display areas.
 - B. Track pass, if purchased, indicates your allocated track time and briefing time.
 - C. Vehicle entry pass, if you are displaying your vehicles as part of a Club stand your pass will show the area. If this is not displayed in the vehicle you may be directed to the public car parking areas.
- 16*. **Camping and overnight facilities**
With the exception of the Classic, Retro and Sports Car day overnight camping is not permitted. To purchase an overnight camping pass (at £10 per pitch per night) for the Classic, Retro and Sports Car Action Day please contact the circuit office on 01249 782417.

PASSES - Passes will only be sent once full payment is received. **CAMPING IS NOT PERMITTED.**

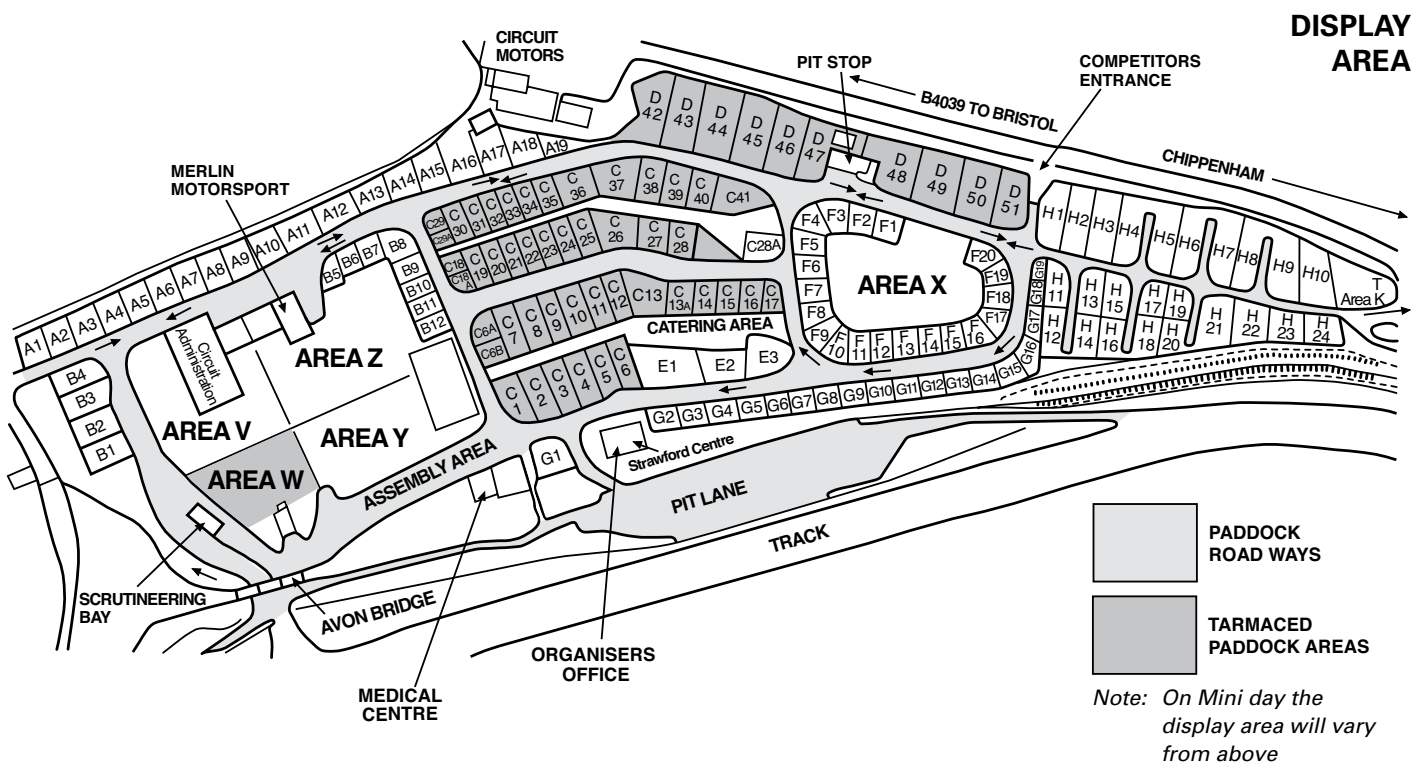
